Albert Hall is a hidden gem in the heart of the city with eclectic gothic and baroque inspired architecture. A forgotten, Wesleyan chapel and Grade II listed building, this striking find is in the process of being refurbished. As such, whilst the venue is a living concerts and events space, please be aware that the building is in a state of revival. This is an exciting journey of discovery for Camerata, and we invite you to come with us on that journey.

SEATING

The stalls are located on the first floor and the balcony on the second, with stair climber access for wheelchairs only. The seating in the balcony takes the form of stepped risers with no backs, and whilst these offer spectacular views of the hall, please feel free to bring a cushion for added comfort if you wish. Chaired seating is provided in the stalls. Within each price band area, seating is unreserved and so will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis. Please note, seat numbers displayed on the booking website do not apply.

GETTING THERE

BY TRAIN

Deansgate Train station, which is located just 500 metres away, provides a direct route to Albert Hall. Other nearby stations include Salford Central and Oxford Road. Manchester Piccadilly is a short taxi ride or approximately a 15 minute walk, alternatively visitors can use the free Metroshuttle bus service.



BY CAR – WHERE TO PARK

Albert Hall is easily accessed by car with 24 hour secure parking for over 1,200 cars in the Great Northern leisure complex which is directly opposite the hall. Entrance to the NCP car park is on Watson Street, behind the Great Northern development.

BY BUS

Albert Hall is well served by local bus routes along Deansgate and John Dalton Street, including the Metroshuttle free bus service. Metroshuttles are free buses linking the main rail stations, car parks, shopping areas and businesses in Manchester city centre. Metroshuttle buses, No.3 (purple), No2 (Green) or No1 (Orange), run from Piccadilly, Salford Central, Victoria, Oxford Road and Deansgate rail stations. There are three circular routes covering the main areas in the city centre.
