For the season finale concert, Manchester Camerata's principal players perform two melodic masterpieces of chamber repertoire.

Beethoven's *Septet in E flat major* is an endlessly charming and lyrical work. Hugely inventive and almost symphonic in scale, the *Septet* was one of Beethoven's most successful and popular works, transcribed for many different forces. Written almost 100 years later, Brahms' *Clarinet Quintet in B minor* was one of a number of late works inspired by his meeting with the clarinetist Richard Muhlfeld. Richly melodic and sublime. Enjoy!
